1. The length of the paper including tables, diagrams, illustrations, etc, should not exceed 20 double-spaced pages.
2. The papers submitted for the ICA Annual Conference should not have been published or sent for publication or presented or sent for consideration in any other Seminar/Conference etc.
3. All correspondence shall be made by and with the FIRST author only.
4. The papers can be submitted electronically only through the conference QR Code.
5. All papers submitted will be subject to the ethical policy of the ICA as given on the ICA Website : <https://icaindia.info/journals/>
6. Paper Contributors are advised to follow the UGC guidelines for the maintenance of standards and plagiarism : (https://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/7771545_academicintegrity-Regulation2018.pdf).

7. All papers submitted will be subject to review by the technical session chairperson /co-chairperson of the concerned session.
8. The first page of the paper should consist of the Title of the Paper, Name(s) of the author(s) with complete details including the mobile numbers and email IDs and an abstract not exceeding 150 words.
9. Second page should start with the title of the paper followed by the text.
10. For Footnotes and Referencing the same guidelines shall be applicable as prescribed for the Indian Journal of Commerce (<https://icaindia.info/journals/>).
11. Reference citation to be strictly in accordance with the APA referencing style.

ETHICAL POLICY

1. The ICA aspires to promote original research paper/articles enhancing knowledge and social relevance through highest quality of transparent, and fair peer review. At every step ethical principles shall be followed.
2. The Indian Commerce Association strives to maintain highest standard pertaining to plagiarism by stressing upon full and prominent disclosure of original source at the time of submission of the paper.
3. Maximum permissible similarity index is 10%. It will be the sole responsibility of the author(s) to submit a certificate to this effect generated by the Officially Recommended Software of UGC like URKUND or TURNITIN while submitting their research papers.
4. Papers submitted without similarity index certificate shall be summarily rejected. The concerned Technical Session Chairperson / Co-Chairperson may re-check the similarity index and review the papers submitted and the papers that could not comply the 'Guidelines to Contributors and Ethical Policy' may be rejected.
5. The UGC guidelines related to plagiarism have been implemented in letter and spirit and must be followed by the authors.
6. It is not necessary that the paper(s) accepted for presentation during the AICC shall also be

published in the Indian Journal of Commerce. Selected papers will be published in the journal of ICA including two best papers of each session.

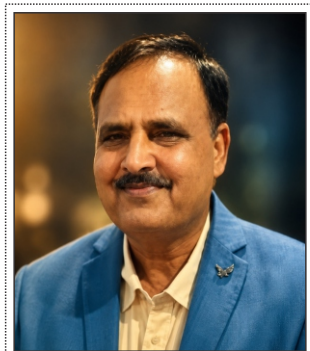

TRAVEL INFORMATION

AIR TRANSPORT:

Air transport in Bhopal is provided through Raja Bhoj Airport (IATA: BHO), the primary airport serving the capital city of Madhya Pradesh. Located in Gandhi Nagar, approximately 15 km northwest of the city centre. Raja Bhoj Airport is located approximately 38 km from the SAGE University Bhopal campus. A taxi ride from the airport to the university takes about 50 to 60 minutes.



RAILWAY TRANSPORT:

Railway transport is one of the most convenient and economical modes of travel to and from Bhopal. The city is a major railway hub in Central India and is served by the West Central Railway Zone of Indian Railways. Bhopal is strategically located on the Delhi–Chennai main railway line, providing excellent connectivity with major cities across the country.



Rail Connectivity

Bhopal enjoys direct train services to almost all major Indian cities, including : Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Ahmedabad, Nagpur, Indore and Premium trains such as Vande Bharat Express, Shatabdi Express, Rajdhani Express, and several Superfast and Express trains. The driving distance between Rani Kamalapati Railway Station and SAGE University Bhopal is approximately 12.3 km and The distance between Bhopal Junction Railway Station and SAGE University (Katara Hills) is approximately 15 to 19 km.

BUS TRANSPORT:

Bus transport is one of the most economical and convenient ways to travel to and within Bhopal. The city has an extensive road network and is well connected to major cities in Madhya Pradesh and neighboring states through national highways and state highways. Long-distance and local bus services make Bhopal an important road transport hub in Central India. The distance from the ISBT – Kushabhau Thackrey Inter State Bus Terminus to Sanjeev Agrawal Global Educational (SAGE) University Bhopal (Katara Hills Campus) is approximately 8–10 km and Travel time: 15–25 minutes by car or taxi.

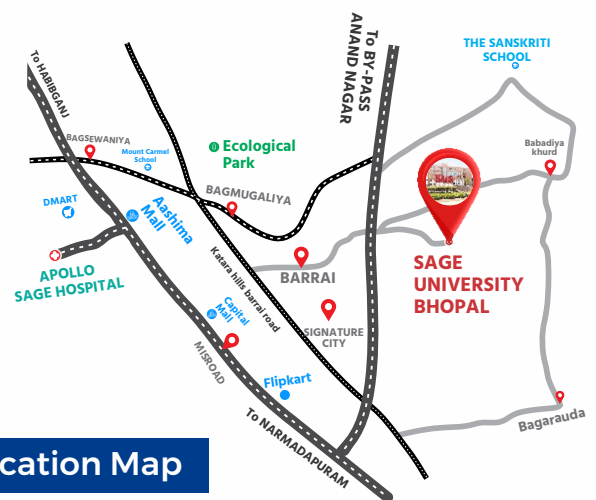
